The winners have their photo recorded for posterity in the PBL on display cabinet outside the Stage 2 classrooms.

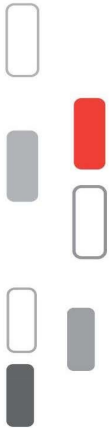

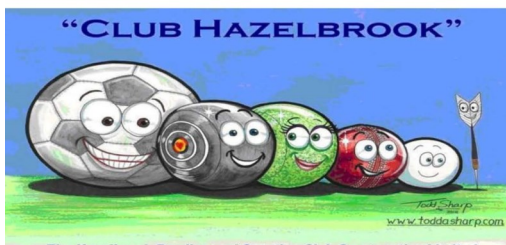
