Some areas of the school will be out of bounds due to the event being at night. Please adhere to the signs and listen to volunteers in yellow vests about where to stay away from.

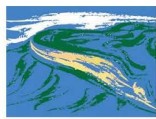
All gates to the school will be open so please park in adjoining streets or at the scout hall.
