Dear Families,

Welcome to Week 8 of Term 2! This week the Department has announced further changes to school activities. Please note that our current drop off and pick up procedures will remain until further notice. In addition to what we are already doing, activities allowed from Monday 15 June, 2020 include:

- All Department of Community and Justice activities including:
 - external counselling services
 - domestic and family violence services
 - family support services
 - targeted early intervention programs
 - supported playgroups
 - School assemblies (limited to 15 minutes and no external visitors)
 - [Choirs and performing arts](#) (within school setting only at this point, no inter-school activities)
 - Incursions/external adult providers to support delivery of curriculum (e.g. music tutors, sport skills development programs, science demonstrations, drama tutors, Healthy Harold). Must maintain distancing and hygiene requirements.
 - Students may attend other schools for essential curriculum related reasons or placements (e.g. auditions or placement tests)
 - Day field trips to outdoor locations with no physical distancing requirements (e.g. DoE Environmental Education Centres and sport and recreation facilities, trips to local river to collect water samples)
 - Community use activities used by students such as dance classes, and student sport skills development related activities outside of school hours with limited adult attendance (curriculum and extra-curriculum purposes)
 - Community use activities on weekends involving adult attendance (complying with relevant guidelines) not essential to continuity of education
 - School photos (although no group staff photos).

We are very excited to be able to move forward with many of our planned extra-curricula activities and programs that we have been waiting to get started again.

Changes to the opportunity class placement process for 2020 Year 4 students

The 2021 Year 5 opportunity class placement process was put on hold in April 2020 due to the COVID-19 situation.

We now have a revised and simplified timeline for the OC placement process to ensure that students and families can have certainty about their placement as soon as possible.

The changes include:

A new date for online applications. Parents must apply between **9 June 2020 and 26 June 2020**. Late applications cannot be accepted.

A new test date - Wednesday **16 September 2020**.

To ensure fair and consistent assessment of students across New South Wales, students will be offered places based only on their test results this year – there will be no school assessment scores.

There will also be no opportunity for appeals given the tight timeframes.

K-2 Parent Teacher Interviews



This week's bell song is 'Six Months in a Leaky Boat' by Split Enz.

Split Enz were a New Zealand rock band that were founded in 1973 and disbanded in 1984. They had eight songs listed in the APRA Top 100 New Zealand Songs of All Time, more than any other band. Split Enz had ten albums (including seven studio albums) reach the top ten of the Official New Zealand Music Chart. From 1980 to 1982, the band had four number-one albums in New Zealand and three in Australia.

'**Six Months in a Leaky Boat**' was released in 1982. It was a single from the band's 7th album, 'Time and Tide'. It was written by Tim Finn. It reached number 2 on the Australian Singles Chart.

The reason why this song was chosen to be this week's bell song:

Congratulations to New Zealand. Benefiting from its initial Level 4 lockdown measures, New Zealand has now returned to a life that reflects pre-COVID normal.
